



FEEL GOOD FUN: HANDPRINT CARROT PATCH CRAFT

Have you ever wondered where carrots grow? We have the perfect craft to help you answer this question! With our handprint carrot patch craft, you and your family will be pulling up the sweetest carrots in the patch!













WHAT YOU NEED:

paper plate scissors orange cardstock glue

green tissue paper stapler (or tape, other types of glue)

brown crayon orange marker (optional)



Be sure to ask an adult for help and permission before trying out this activity!

STEPS:

- 1) Begin by cutting a paper plate in half. Line the two half pieces together and staple around the outside edge (tape or glue works too), forming a pocket with the paper plate pieces.
- Color the paper plate with a brown crayon.
- 3 Next, trace your hand with the brown crayon. Use the scissors to cut out the handprint. Once the handprint is cut out, use an orange marker (or brown crayon) to draw short lines across each finger.
- 4 Rip pieces of green tissue paper and glue them to the tips of the fingers.
- Slip the handprint into the paper plate pocket. Voila! The carrots are growing from the soil in the ground!
